Participation in the work leading up to, and following the Germanwings task force Recommendations

Several members of ESAMs bodies have participated in the work leading to EASAs recommendations after the Germanwings tragedy. Even though not all, much of the input from ESAM has been followed up in the final recommendations. ESAM continues to be involved in the implementation of some of the important recommendations in order to improve flight safety in Europe.

In particular, ESAM has in 2016 been a founding member of EPPSI – European Pilot Peer Support Initiative, in collaboration with European Association for Aviation Psychology (EAAP), European Cockpit Association (ECA) and Stiftung Mayday. (www.eppsi.eu)
